What is MESA?

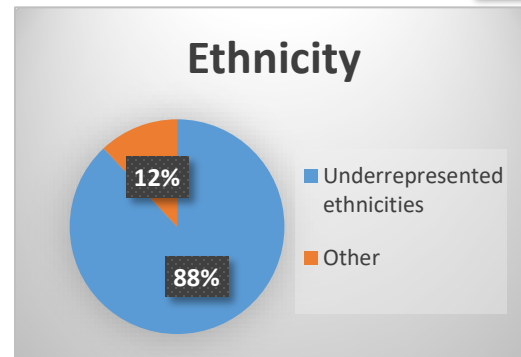
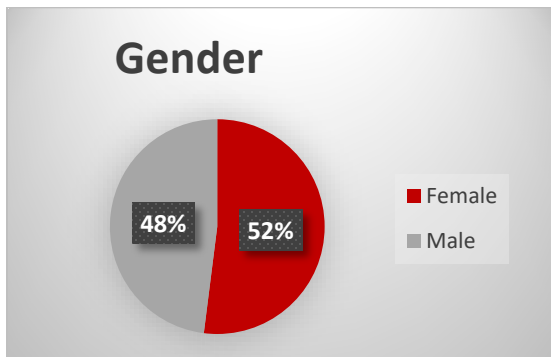
